Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope you had quality time bonding with your children over the short Term 1 break. The school is excited to welcome your children back and we look forward to the continued partnership with you in the development of your children.

### SCHOOL ATTIRE AND PUNCTUALITY

2. All pupils are reminded to look neat and smart when wearing their school uniform. Shirts (including PE shirt) must be tucked in neatly at all times. **They must also have their name tags on their school uniform and PE attire.**

3. All pupils are expected to be in school **by 7.25 a.m.** for our flag raising assembly. In Term 1, we noticed pupils either being dropped off by parents at the foyer or walking into the school after 7.30 a.m. While we have spoken to the pupils on the importance of punctuality, we seek the help of parents in reinforcing this message.

### STUDENTS WHO ARE UNWELL

4. Safeguarding the health and well-being of our pupils is our collective responsibility. We seek your cooperation in taking your child/ward to see a doctor if he/she is unwell especially when he/she develops flu-like symptoms. In the event that your child is already in school and is unwell during curriculum hours, we will contact you to take your child home from school as he/she may need medical attention. It will also be helpful if you can save the school's contact number **(6269 7410)** so that you will know when the school contacts you, especially during emergencies.

### ROAD SAFETY DURING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

The safety and security of our pupils are our top priority. We have put in place measures to make sure that the school is safe and secure for our pupils.

5. **Arrival time:** For parents who are driving into the school in the morning, we seek your understanding and cooperation to get your child ready to alight safely and quickly at the drop-off points at the foyer. This is in consideration of other parents/drivers and to avoid congestion both within the school as well as the road along Woodlands Drive 50. Thank you to all parents and drivers who have been considerate and patient when driving your child into the school.

6. **Dismissal time:** We have noticed of that some parents continue to park their cars just outside Gate F despite reminders. **We would like to appeal to parents to park at the designated carpark lots and avoid parking or stopping their cars outside Gate F**, as this can pose as a safety hazard as well as cause a build-up of traffic.

7. In addition, we would like to appeal to parents waiting outside Gate D during dismissal time to wait opposite the gate or under the void deck opposite the school. The passageway outside the school gate is narrow. It is hence not conducive for parents to wait there due to the volume of pupils exiting Gate D during dismissal. We seek parents' cooperation in heeding the advice of our Parent Support Group members and teachers on duty should you be asked to make way for pupils exiting the gate.
